



Golden Eagle Award

Grade 4



The Golden Eagle Award is designed for those students who demonstrate exemplary performance within school and the community. Fourth grade students may earn this award by completing 13 of the requirements below. This application and all requirements must be compiled in a binder or folder and submitted to the homeroom teacher by Wednesday, May 1.

	Receive no SOAR violation slips during the school year
	Maintain exemplary attendance in school (4 or fewer absences)
	Maintain consistent punctuality in school (4 or fewer tardies)
	Maintain an average grade of 3 or higher on each quarter report card
	Complete 10 hours of community service. Preapproval by teacher is required.
	Demonstrate proficiency on each GoMath chapter test by achieving a minimum of 80%.
	Demonstrate proficiency (100% accuracy) on multiplication facts tests up to and including 12 by April 1. (2 points)
	Demonstrate proficiency (100% accuracy) on division facts tests up to and including 12 by April 1. (2 points)
	Write a persuasive essay on a topic preapproved by the teacher. The essay must be 2 typed pages, double-spaced, size 12 font. It must follow a standard essay writing model. (2 points)
	Write an informative essay on a topic preapproved by the teacher. The essay must be 2 typed pages, double-spaced, size 12 font. It must follow a standard essay writing model. (2 points)
	Demonstrate improvement in DIBELS over each preceding test
	Participate in the science fair
	Write a science report on any of the 4th grade science core topics, including the water cycle, weather, rocks, soil, fossils, and habitats. The report must be 2 typed pages, double-spaced, size 12 font.
	Create a multi-media project on any of the 4th grade science core topics, including the water cycle, weather, rocks, soil, fossils, and habitats.
	Participate in an extracurricular activity hosted at Eastwood, including chess club, Lego League, band, orchestra, Mad Science, Kids Stage, and Girls on the Run
	Participate in the dance festival
	Submit a minimum of 100 box tops during the year
	Complete an activity of choice that is preapproved by the teacher
